Passage: Psalm 150

It's Friday! So glad you made it this far with us!

Praise and worship, that's what this Psalm is about. Before we read spend a few moments in prayer to the Lord!

READ & DIG. Read Psalm 150 (underline anything that sticks out to you)

PRAISE THE LORD

What the most said phrase in Psalm 150? *Praise the Lord.*

That's the focus of the Psalm... As the last Psalm in the book it ends where each of the Psalms are rooted – in praising the Lord.

The Psalmist paints a picture of what to be thankful for in v1-2, *his mighty deeds!*

So, take a second and think about all of the reasons you have to be thankful to the Lord...

Salvation, family, friends, school, your home, your talents, your future...

We have so much to be thankful for and those are just a few.

So, lets as this question how should we praise God?

(2b) *according to his excellent greatness!*

Our praise should be according to how great he is! Now, we'll never ever reach that, but we should strive to glorify him in all we can!

Now, praising God doesn't just happen through praise and worship music! It can happen in all aspects of life... *the way you play sports, the way you talk, the way you love others, the way you eat...* In everything you say, do and think you are choosing either to praise God or praise something (or someone) else!

We often don't praise the Lord enough for all he does for us.

I want us to cut this devo short and I want you to spend some time in prayer praising the Lord.

Praise him for everything he has done for you and everything is going to...

Apply & GO

So, God is worthy of our praise, we should praise him in all of our lives!

- **Salvation....** thank him for providing Jesus and saving you!
- **Family...** thank him for your family, regardless of what the situation looks like!
- **Friends...** thank him for the godly influences in your life who push you closer to Christ!
- **School...** yes! even pray for school! You are blessed to get an education!
- **Home...** thank him for your home – roof over your head, food on the table!
- **Talents...** thank him for his gifts to you!
- **His plan for your life...** thank him for his plan for your life, his perfect plan!
